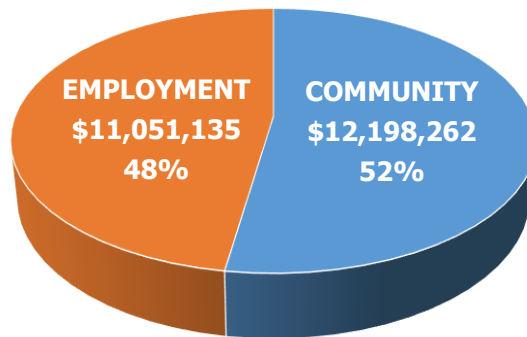


Our Vision for St. Louis County: Individuals of all abilities are provided with opportunities that allow them to fulfill their potential and live as respected and included members of the community

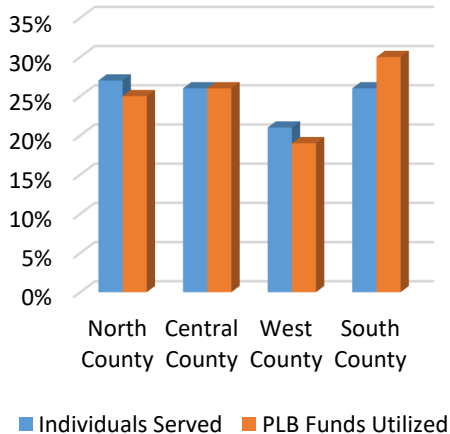

97% of individuals receiving supports from PLB funded agencies are satisfied with the services they receive.

82% of individuals served are increasing or maintaining their level of independence.
